

The Fort Gordon Army Fisher House is a home away from home for families of patients who are currently admitted at Dwight David Eisenhower Army Medical Center (EAMC) and the family members. The Army Fisher House is a temporary residence and not a treatment facility, hospice, transient lodging facility, or counseling center. Health care providers are not on the Army Fisher House staff.

The Army Fisher House referral form can be completed by the patient's Health Care Provider, Social Worker, and or Case Manager at the ward/clinic at EAMC. Referrals can also be made through the EAMC American Red Cross, EAMC Chaplains, and the ward that the patient is admitted on at EAMC.

The Army Fisher House referral form needs to be filled out completely, signed by the healthcare provider with their contact information, and should be faxed to the Fisher House fax number at 706-787-5106 and follow up with a phone call to the Army Fisher House at 706-787-7100.

Families are accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis when the Army Fisher House Referral is validated and space is available. When the Fisher House is full, the Fisher House Manager maintains a waiting list. Exceptions can be made by the Army Fisher House Manager based on medical priority and other factors. If the Army Fisher House is full, the Manager can assist with overflow lodging options and other programs.

During normal duty hours: Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., contact number 706-787-7100. For placement into the Army Fisher House during non-duty hours (Evening, Weekends, and Holidays) contact the Staff Duty Officer (SDO) / Administrative Officer of the Day (AOD) at EAMC AOD Desk number: 706-787-6019/2770/6938, or AOD Cell number: 706-830-1405.

The Fisher House has seven individual rooms, all of which include a full bath. The rooms sleep two to four guests depending on the room available at the time. Residents share a common living room, kitchen, and laundry area. Housekeeping in the guestroom and common areas are the responsibility residents. EAMC and the Army Fisher House are tobacco-free.

Families are strongly encouraged to make back up lodging arrangements before they arrive in the Augusta area. This ensures that the families have a place to stay if the Fort Gordon Army Fisher House is full.
